“A Tale of Three Privies”

The Thomaston Historical Society presents Leon “Lee” Cranmer’s “A Tale of Three Privies.” Mr. Cranmer recounts the archeological excavations of outhouses on three sites: an 18th century fort, a 19th century farmstead, and a 19th century urban house. Analysis of the artifacts found in these privies paints a picture of the lifestyle of the sites’ occupants and an understanding of the material culture of the time.
